ACADEMY DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

The 2025 Annual Report reflects a year of growth, commitment, and steady progress for the Green-Kenya Football Academy. Guided by a clear vision to nurture young talent through quality coaching, competitive exposure, leadership development, and life-skills education, the Academy continued to deliver a structured, child-centred football programme. The year began with strong motivation from both coaches and players, supported by strategic planning meetings in January that helped align objectives, strengthen programme structure, and clarify player development pathways.

One of the highlights of the year was our participation in the Accenture League, which provided valuable competitive exposure and reinforced the confidence, discipline, and teamwork of our players. Throughout the year, 499 players actively took part in Academy sessions, benefiting from consistent, competency-based training delivered in a safe, inclusive, and enjoyable environment. We also held two parents' meetings, strengthening communication, building trust, and reinforcing the shared responsibility of supporting children's development both on and off the pitch.

As we look ahead, the Academy is taking important steps to expand access and deepen impact. We are remodelling our sponsored players programme to create more opportunities for children from less fortunate backgrounds to take part in organised sport. In the coming year, we will also sharpen our competitive focus by prioritising four key tournaments: the Accenture League, FKF Under 13 and Under 15 competitions, the Norway Cup, and the Diani Cup. These platforms will not only enhance player development and exposure but also reaffirm our commitment to providing meaningful pathways for young players to grow, compete, and thrive.

Player Development & Coaching Philosophy

Competitive participation remained central to player growth in 2025. The Academy took part in league and friendly matches throughout the year, allowing players to apply technical skills in real-game situations and build confidence under pressure.

Training emphasis evolved seasonally, focusing on:

- ⚽ Technical fundamentals (passing, dribbling, finishing)
- ⚽ Tactical awareness and decision-making
- ⚽ Communication, teamwork, and fair play
- ⚽ Physical conditioning and injury prevention, including gym exposure for Under-13 and Under-15 player

We continue to prioritise safe, professional, and well-equipped training environments by improving our pitches, upgrading training equipment, strengthening first-aid and safety protocols, and providing better gear and uniforms for our players. Looking ahead, our key dream is to develop a full 11-a-side turf pitch, a project that will greatly elevate the level of football in the community we serve by offering a safer playing surface, reducing injuries, enabling year-round training, and creating opportunities to host matches and tournaments; this facility will play a vital role in advancing player development, talent exposure, and community growth as we work together with parents, partners, and supporters to make this vision a reality.


